

TRAIL CONDITIONS



When you set out on the trail, are you aware of the conditions you will encounter?

Challenges are possible on access roads, at trailheads, on the trails, at creek crossings. Are there trail closures or new regulations? Are there missing signs, confusing junctions or other navigational difficulties? Is the trail buried in snow or mud? Is the trail damaged by erosion, fire or downfall? Are creeks running high? Are bridges, logs or stepping-stones missing or impaired? Are there problems with wild animals?

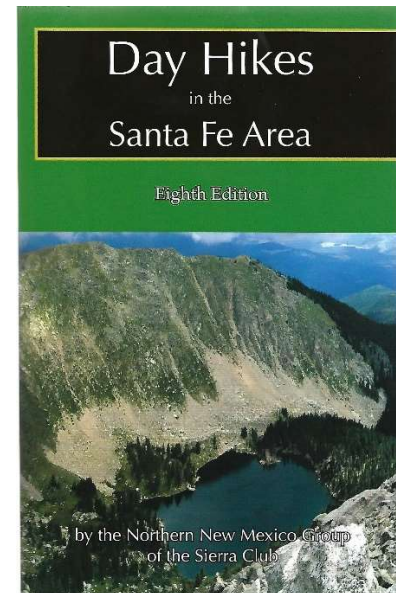
To avoid the unexpected, consult the Santa Fe Trails Message Board before you hike.
